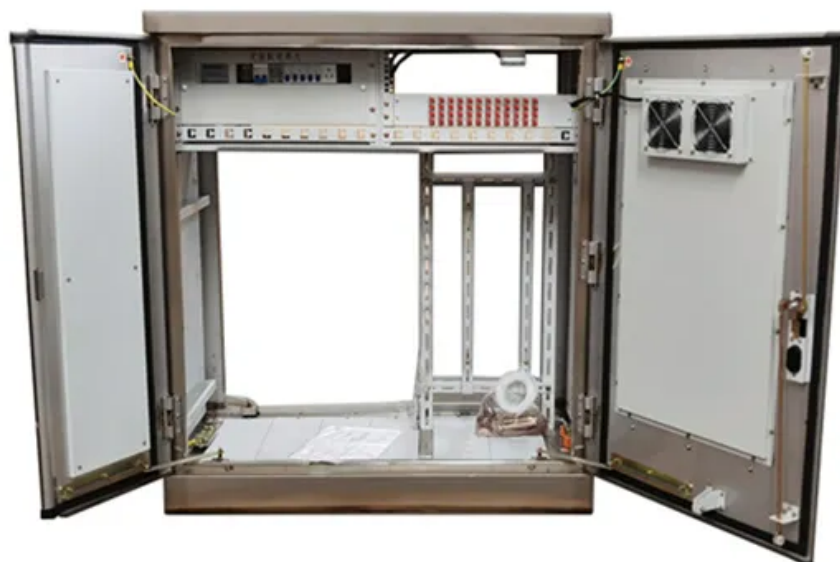


Where are the base stations of Mozambique s communication network



Overview

There are now three international subsea cables landing in Mozambique, SEACOM (2009) and EASSy (2010) landing in Maputo, and 2Africa (2023) landing in both Maputo and Nacala. Telecommunications in Mozambique include radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet. AM 13, FM 17, shortwave 11 (2001). Television stations: 1 state-run TV station supplemented by private TV station; Portuguese state TV's African service, RTP Africa, and Brazilian-owned TV. Overview: A subsidiary of South Africa's Vodacom Group, Vodacom is the market leader with ~50% market share in mobile subscriptions. Services: Offers mobile voice, 3G/4G broadband, and M-Pesa (mobile money), with 8. 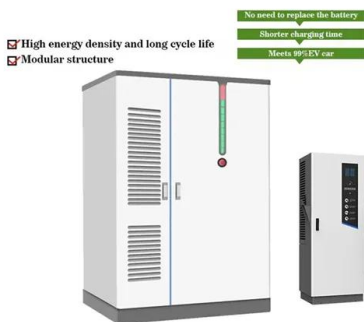
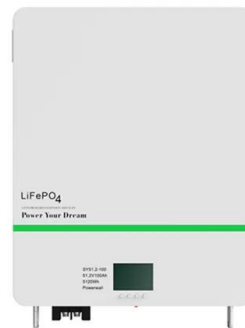
Telecommunications in Mozambique
